REGISTRATION AND SCHOOL FEES 2023-2024

NEW STUDENTS	
\$50	Application Fee: This non-refundable fee must be paid when the application is submitted.
\$30	Assessment Testing Fee: This fee must be paid directly to the teacher administering the assessment on the testing date.
\$200	Registration Fee: This non-refundable fee must be paid when the applicant is accepted as a student at CHS.
\$250	General School Fee: This fee includes insurance, textbooks, lab fees, classroom supplies, campus safety systems, and other start-up expenses for each academic year. This fee must be paid on the first day of school.

RETURNING STUDENTS	
\$200	Registration Fee: This non-refundable fee must be paid when a student is re-enrolled at CHS. The student's name will not be added to the 2023-2024 roster until this fee is paid.
\$250	General School Fee: This fee includes insurance, textbooks, lab fees, classroom supplies, campus safety systems, and other start-up expenses for each academic year. This fee must be paid on the first day of school.

TUITION PAYMENT SCHEDULE 2023-2024

Miscellaneous Fees: Apart from registration, general school fees, and tuition, there are additional expenses for supplementary literature books, field study trips, concerts, school photos, etc. There is a \$65 per sport participation fee.
